



TWINNING/ EXCHANGE PROGRAMME
between
Manipal University and Flinders University

Degree: MSc Medical Biotechnology

Duration: Two years

Eligibility:

Applicants for the scholarship must:

- (a) a student who is a graduate of the Manipal University Bachelor of Biotechnology degree; and
- (b) enrolled as a full-time student in the Master of Biotechnology Studies; and
- (c) have achieved a Distinction average for the 3 years of the Manipal University Bachelor degree; and
- (d) not be in receipt of another scholarship; and
- (e) be nominated for the scholarship by the Head, Department of Biotechnology, Manipal University

Fee structure/ Scholarship:

The scholarship provides fee remission of 25% of the annual standard international student tuition fee charged by Flinders University for the Master of Biotechnology Studies course. The scholarship is awarded for up to two years of study, subject to the scholarship holder maintaining their enrolment, and satisfactory academic performance as determined by the Course Coordinator.

Scholarship holders must remain enrolled full-time in the years in which the scholarship is awarded. The scholarship will terminate if the scholarship holder withdraws or is precluded from the course, and will not be available for a repeat year of study.

Students awarded a scholarship under this scheme will be required to pay the balance of their tuition fees, together with all other study-related and living expenses, including Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC). The scholarship will terminate if the scholarship holder is granted Australian permanent resident status.
