This is the first time in the history of both these centres that an Indian has been invited to serve as Visiting Professor.





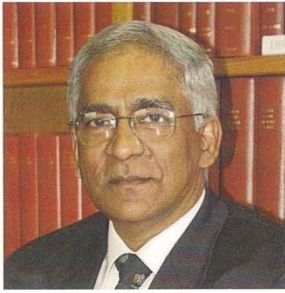

We were honored to have the world-renowned children's orthopedic surgeon, Professor Benjamin Joseph of Manipal, India, serve as our Visiting Professor this year on 21-22 April, 2011.

Professor Joseph serves as Professor of Orthopedics and Head of Pediatric Orthopedics at the Kasturba Medical College in Manipal, India. His medical school education was at the Christian Medical College in Vellore, India, with postgraduate orthopedic training at the Kasturba Medical College. He completed a fellowship in orthopedics at the University of Liverpool in the United Kingdom and was one of John Sharrard's last clinical fellows.

Dr. Joseph's academic career includes many honors, including visiting professorships throughout Asia and North America, as well as receiving the Professor John Sharrard Memorial Medal of the British Society for Children's Orthopedic Surgery in 2006. He recently completed a one year sabbatical in New Zealand.

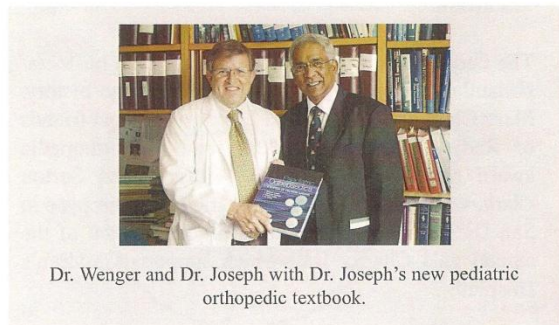
Dr. Joseph has many areas of research interest, primarily focused on the hip in children, with a special interest in Perthes disease. He recently authored the 2009 international textbook entitled "Paediatric Orthopaedics – A System of Decision Making" along with Mr. Selvadurai Nayagam (U.K.), Dr. Randy Loder (U.S.A.), and Mr. Ian Torode (Australia).

During his visiting professorship, Dr. Joseph demonstrated his comprehensive understanding of children's orthopedics, explaining the benefit of a systemic approach to treating children. He also emphasized methods that allow effective economical orthopedic care for children. His lecture to the Pediatric/Orthopedic combined Grand Rounds entitled "Limiting Locomotor Disability in Children with Limited Resources" was brilliant, as was his evening talk to the Western Orthopedic Association -- "Consumerism and Pediatric Orthopedics".

This was one of our best Visiting Professorships ever, with many of our prior fellows attending. The adjacent photographs demonstrate clinical and social activities associated with this annual event.




