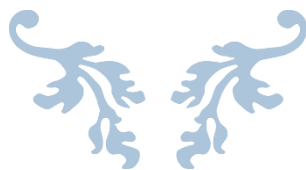

5. Academic Eligibility:

The academic [eligibility](#) as laid down by DASA 2026 is as follows

- **Nationality:** Candidates who are of Foreign Nationals or Overseas Citizens of India (OCI) or Persons of Indian Origin (PIOs) or Non-Resident Indians (NRIs) are eligible. Please refer to the [DASA information brochure](#) for details.
- **Age:** Candidates born on or after October 01, 2001, are eligible. Date of birth as recorded in the Secondary Education Board / University Certificate [Class X or equivalent] or any certificate issued by the Government authorities only will be taken as authentic.
- **Academic Eligibility:** Candidate should have valid JEE (Main) 2026 score card and rank(s) of Paper 1 (B.E./B. Tech.) for B.E./B.Tech. programs. In addition, candidates must satisfy the minimum percentage requirement in Class XII (that is Senior Secondary [10+2]) or equivalent [See Annexure 2 of [DASA 2026](#)] from any system of education as recognized by the Association of Indian Universities (www.aiu.ac.in) with specified subjects as mentioned below. Candidates appearing for Class XII examination or equivalent in the academic year 2025-26 and expecting their final results latest by September 30, 2026, may also apply.
- **For B.E./B.Tech.:** Candidates should have successfully completed Mathematics, Physics and one of the subjects from (Chemistry, Biotechnology, Computer Science, Biology) in Class XII with 75% marks (CGPA of 7.5 out of 10) in aggregate in 5 subjects, as applicable in the respective boards. Please refer to Annexure 2(b) of JoSAA 2026 Business Rule (<https://josaa.nic.in>).
- **Residential requirement:** All foreign nationals studying in any country including India or Indian nationals studying abroad who fulfil prescribed admission criteria shall be eligible. Prescribed admission criteria for Indian Nationals shall be at least two years of education, inclusive of 11th and 12th or equivalent (not beyond), in a foreign country during the last 8 years and must pass the same from abroad. Candidates eligible for both DASA 2026 (UG) are advised to refer the document entitled Important Information for candidates registering for both DASA 2026 (UG) which is available in the website <https://csab.nic.in>.
- **Seat allocation:** Each qualified candidate is categorized based on nationality as given below:
 - **Category tag DASA (SAARC):** This is assigned to Foreign Nationals / Overseas Citizens of India (OCI) / Persons of Indian Origin (PIOs), who are nationals of SAARC countries (except India).
 - **Category tag DASA (Non - SAARC):** This is assigned to Foreign Nationals / Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) / Persons of Indian Origin (PIOs), who are NOT nationals of SAARC countries. This tag is also assigned to Non-Resident Indians (NRI).

- **Category tag DASA-CIWG:** This is assigned to Non- Resident Indians (NRIs) whose either OR both of the parents are working in gulf country [United Arab Emirates, Bahrain, Iraq, Iran, Kuwait, Oman, Qatar, Saudi Arabia]. NRI candidates who are eligible for CIWG seats will have the option to be considered for Non-CIWG seats as well under DASA (Non-SAARC) category tag only.

6.2 DASA SAARC:

Students from SAARC countries/nationality would be eligible for 20% Scholarship on Program fee. The fee mentioned below is after applying scholarship. Scholarship will be extended in the subsequent years only to those students who have cleared all subjects in the University Examinations of previous year before the due date for payment of annual program fee. Scholars, who are promoted to next year with failures (F) / Incomplete (I) / Detention (DT) grades, are NOT eligible for scholarship and such students MUST pay the full Program fee applicable for that academic year.

7. Scholarship :

Please refer scholarship document made available on MAHE website by [clicking here](#). Manipal also admits foreign nationals through Study in India (SII), COMPEX (Embassy of India Nepal), Indian Council of Cultural Relations (ICCR) etc., with a subsidized fee structure and such students would not be eligible for scholarship.

8. Hostel & Mess Details:

The hostel and mess facilities for academic year 2026 –27 are as follows:

- Hostel residency with attached bathrooms is available for boys and girls separately.
- Number of rooms in both boys and girls hostel blocks is limited and would be allotted on a first-come-first serve basis in the first year
- Every hostel provides facilities like uninterrupted electricity, solar / electric heated water facility, water cooler with aqua guard filters, common telephone, television and reading rooms etc.
- Students will have to bring their own soft furnishings and bed linen.
- Food courts are conveniently located and serve both Veg and Non-Veg cuisines
- Joining a Mess is mandatory for students residing in the MAHE Hostels
- If the student vacates the hostel, his / her hostel facilities fee paid for the year will be forfeited
- Hostel Fee need to be remitted by wire transfer/bank transfer along with the first-year course fee (Refer Payment process details).
