Part 1: System Requirements

- **System Requirements**

- ✓ **System:** Desktop or Laptop
- ✓ **Operating System:** Windows 10 and above (up-to-date service pack, device drivers, security patches, this exam will run only on **Windows operating system**)
- ✓ **Processor:** Intel Core i5 10th Generation or above with 2.4 Ghz or more clock speed
- ✓ **RAM:** 8 GB or above
- ✓ **Screen Resolution:** 1024 x 768 and Above
- ✓ **Browser:** Latest version of Chrome (112 or above) and .Net Version 4.5.2 or above - Download / Update latest version from https://www.google.com/intl/en_in/chrome/
 - Disable ad blocker / pop up blocker under Chrome Extensions
- ✓ **Web camera (Primary Camera):** Resolution 640 x 480, 15 frames per second (fps) (Internal or External and connected to computer, Camera must run natively in OS and not with help of other software)
 - Enable webcam and mic under Chrome settings Extensions
- ✓ **Secondary Camera:**
Mobile Phone / Tablet with Stable internet connection and Camera: This is required which will act as a secondary camera.

- **Hardware Requirements**

- **Device:** Smartphone / Tablet only (Android only)
- **Camera:** Front camera (minimum 5 MP recommended)
- **Mounting:** Mobile stand / tripod / any other suitable arrangement mandatory to keep device stable. You may also use books, boxes etc. to mount the secondary camera.

- **Software Requirements**

- **Operating System:** Android 8.0 or above
- **Browser / App:** Google Chrome
- **Permissions:** Camera, microphone, and network access enabled

- **Network Requirements**

- **Internet:** Same or separate stable connection.
- **Data Usage:** 2.0 GB (during the final exam)
- **Battery:** 100% charge or connected to power (minimum for 90 mins.)

- **Camera Placement**

- Position the secondary camera **to your side** so that it clearly captures:

- Your **face**
- Your **hands**
- Your **lap**
- Your **computer/laptop screen**
- Your **keyboard and workspace**



- The camera must remain **fixed and live stream the video of the above-mentioned areas throughout the test.**

Important Note:

- It is **MANDATORY** for the candidate to position the primary and secondary cameras **STRICTLY** as per the guidelines of Online Remote Proctored Computer base test and **live stream both Primary and Secondary camera feed** throughout the examination. Failure to follow these instructions will automatically lead to **"disqualification"**.
 - It is the responsibility of the applicant to make suitable arrangements such as compatible laptop/desktop, configuration requirements for the examination.
 - As the examination is online proctored, a good internet connection is required. MAHE will not be held responsible for any disruption in the examination due to configurational or internet related issues.
 - If the candidate fails to follow the examination instructions or causes a breach in the terms and conditions of the examination, or for any other reason, and If any unusual / suspicious activity / behavior of the Candidate is observed during the Examination, MAHE reserves right to conduct detailed audit (such as verification of examination footage, Pattern of attending the questions and overall conduct during the examination etc.), and if found any grounds or reason to believe any malpractice, MAHE in its sole discretion may disqualify such candidate. The decision of MAHE in this regard is binding on the applicants.
- **Technical Issues**
 - Inform the proctor **immediately** if you face any technical problems with the secondary camera.
 - Failure to maintain the secondary camera feed may result in **termination of the test.**
 - Any suspicious activity or camera disruption may lead to **disqualification.**
 - In case of any disruption / disconnection, the QR Code will pop up on the screen. Rescan the QR Code to enable the feed from the secondary camera.

- ✓ **Microphone:** Any Model (External or Internal)
- ✓ **Network response:** Not more than 1000 ms

- In case of shortcomings (if any), we request you to take care of the same to ensure the best test experience during mock and live test.
- Even though you are able to successfully complete this system check on Mobile / Tablet / MacBook, the Safe Examination Browser (SEB) can be installed only on Laptop / Desktop running on **Windows Operating System (Windows 10 and above)**.

- **Internet Requirements**

- **Anti-Virus**

- ✓ Antivirus: 'any make' to be disabled during Safe Exam Browser (SEB) download. Antivirus can be re-enabled post examination

- **Additional requirements**

- ✓ Download Any Desk (<https://anydesk.com/en>) onto your desktop / laptop. This will be helpful for our technical support team to take remote access for any support needed to download the Safe Exam Browser (SEB)
- ✓ Candidate to have administrative privileges on the laptop/desktop to enable installation/uninstallations.

Note

- You **CANNOT** take this test on **Mobile / Tablet / MacBook**. The Safe Examination Browser (SEB) can be installed only on Laptop / Desktop running on Windows Operating System (OS).
- If a candidate is using his / her Laptop / Desktop, then the availability of the Hardware, Software, Broadband Internet & power backup at the time of the exam is the sole responsibility of the candidate and the University will not be responsible for any interruptions in the exam due to failure of the above-mentioned resources at the candidate's end.
- No request will be considered for time extension / rescheduling of the test. Hence, the candidate should ensure and plan the availability of the resources accordingly.



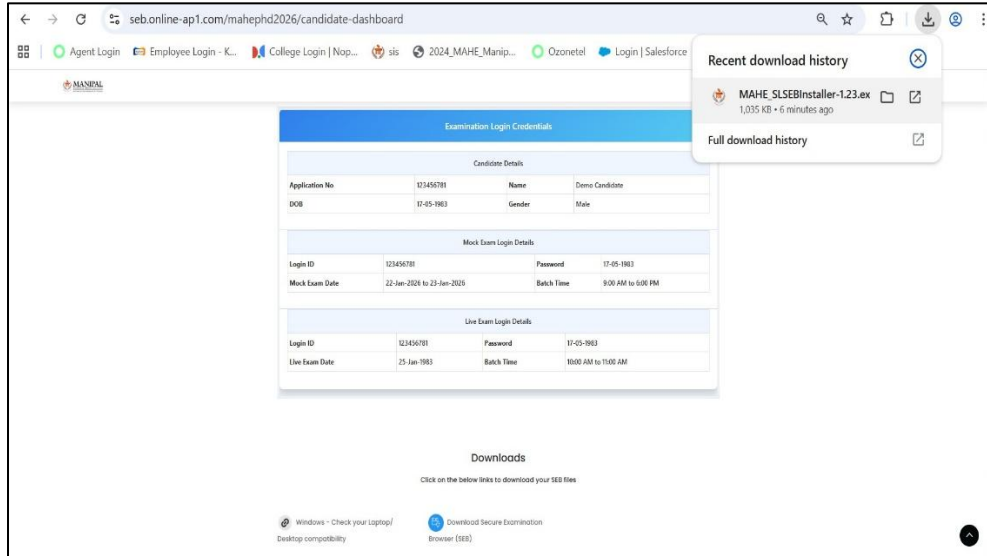

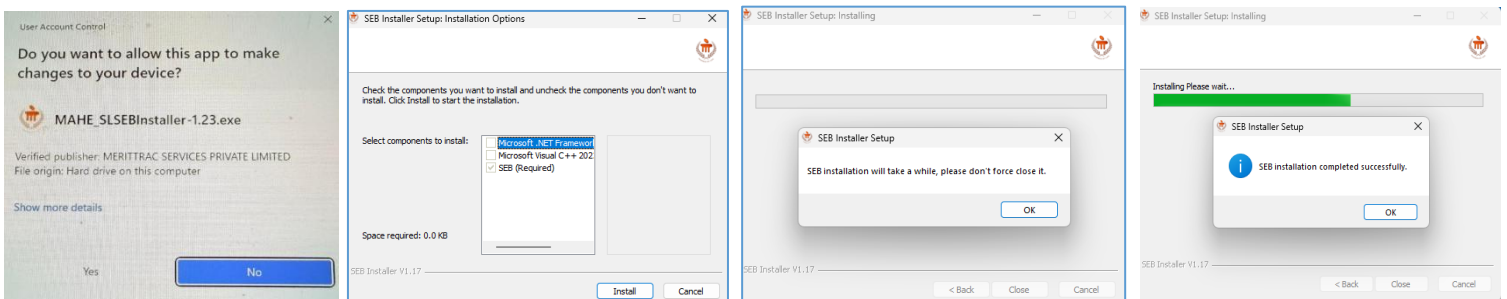
During download, the anti-virus in your system may prompt you to re-confirm download, as it is an .exe file

Part 3: Important Guidelines

3.1 Mock Test

- **Mock Test is mandatory.** Its purpose is to ensure the candidates have the proper technical requirements to take the examination online and will give confidence for the candidates to comfortably appear for the online examinations.
- The candidate **MUST** attempt the Mock Test to get accustomed to the exam interface and to become well conversant with the various features
- The candidate **MUST** ensure that the Laptop / Desktop is in working condition and system ready. The Laptop / Desktop used for the Mock Test must be used for the Final examination

3.2 Examination Venue / Place / Atmosphere

- Candidates must have the **Original hard copy** of the Passport / Driving License / EC Voter ID Card / Aadhaar Card / PAN card or School / College photo-bearing ID card ready at the time of examination.
- It is the candidates' sole responsibility to be properly dressed during the online examination as they are in a public setting.
- Ensure that the physical location is well lit, adequately ventilated, noise / disturbance free.
- The Candidate must sit in a closed room having enough light for the system camera to detect his / her face.
 - Candidate should position himself / herself in front of web camera appropriately with his / her face being clearly visible & he / she should ensure that he / she is being properly recorded by the web camera throughout the exam.
 - The Camera should cover your face and your body up to the upper abdomen.
- Please make sure that there is **NO** noise / disturbance around you during the examination.
- Ensure a continuous and stable supply of electricity throughout the Examination duration
 - Check the power plugs / electrical connectivity
 - Charge the Laptop well in advance to last for at least 2:00 hours **OR** arrange for the backup device (UPS) for the Desktop to last for at least 2:00 hours

3.3 Test Time

- The timing for the Mock Test and Remote Proctored Online Manipal Entrance Test will strictly be as per the **Indian Standard Time (IST)**. This is also applicable to the candidates appearing for the examination from OUTSIDE India.
- A user cannot login to the system after the start time of the examination. Hence, the candidates are required to login at least 30 minutes before the start of the examinations and be ready to take the test. For example, if the test start time is at 10:00 AM, candidates will be able to login to the Safe Examination Browser between 9:30 AM to 10:00 AM ONLY.
- The clock will be set on the server. The countdown timer in the top right corner of the screen will display the remaining time available for the Candidates to complete the examination
- In the event of disconnection of network / power failure during the examination, the examination can be resumed

by logging in only 3 minutes after the instance of interruption.

- However, the candidates should **NOT** take any break for more than 5 minutes. Any such break will be critically analyzed, and University will have every right to declare the results as Null & Void.
- Only a total 5 such logins will be permitted during the entire examination duration (Login Time + Actual Test Time)

3.4 Internet connectivity

- You must ensure that on the day of the examination, at the time of starting the examination, you have enough data (Up to 2.0 GB) at a minimum download / upload speed of 5 Megabits per second (Mbps).
- If you are using the Mobile hotspot, do not share the phone's hotspot with any other device while attending the Test and do not attend ANY calls on that Mobile during the test.
- If your device is using a Wi-Fi router, make sure to sit near the Wi-Fi Router / Modem to avoid any signal related issues.

3.5 Safe Exam Browser (SEB)

To ensure credibility, the Mock Test and the Remote Proctored PhD Manipal Entrance Test (MET) has to be attempted after installing the Safe Exam Browser (SEB). This works only on **Windows Operation System (Version 10 and above)**.

Features of Safe Exam Browser (SEB) are as follows:

- Disables all hotkeys
- Disables access to all system resources
- Disables cut / copy / paste, print screen etc.
- Closes non-required processes at the start and at regular intervals
- Detects duplicate monitors and interrupts the test
- Disables remote access through ports and Bluetooth devices
- Prevents test taking on virtual machines
- Disables all inbound and outbound connections except with the Test Server
- Single tab browser

Safe Examination Browser (SEB) is required for both Mock Test (scheduled during **02 July 2026 9:00 AM to 03 July 2026 6:00 PM**) and PhD MET 2026 Batch 1 (scheduled during **July 05, 2026, 10:00 AM**).

SEB Download

- Kindly visit <https://seb.online-ap1.com/mahephd2026/candidate-login> to download the Safe Examination Browser (SEB). Provision to download the Safe Examination Browser file (SEB.exe) onto your Laptop / Desktop is provided from **02 July 2026 after 9:30 AM**
- Safe Examination Browser (SEB) can be installed only on Laptop / Desktop running on Windows Operating System (Windows 10 and above).
- You MUST restart your Desktop / Laptop to take care of any Windows update
 - a. After the successful installation of SEB
 - b. Within 24 hours of the actual start of Mock Test
 - c. Within 24 hours of the actual start of the Actual Test

3.6 Do's and Don'ts of Remote Proctored Entrance Test

- While attempting the examination, no other application / webpage should be opened except Safe Examination Browser (SEB)
 - Any attempt to open ANY application / webpage will be considered as Malpractice, leading to immediate disqualification from the admission process
- The exam must be taken in the Safe Exam Browser (SEB)

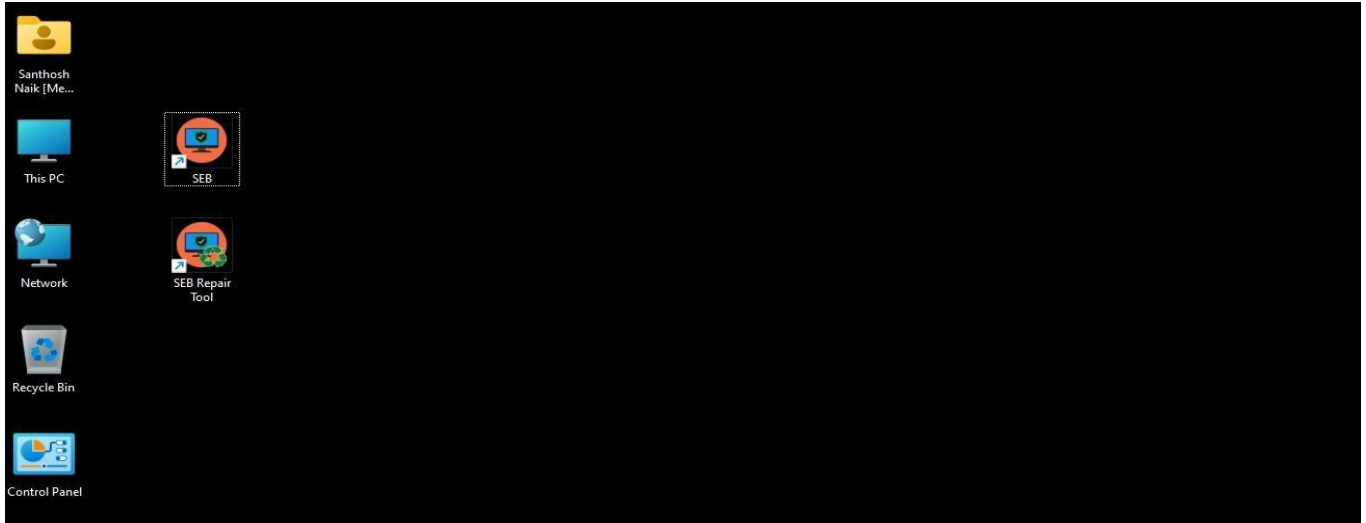
- The materials and contents of the examination should **NOT** be recorded in any way.
- Taking photos or recording videos and sharing them with others or indulging in suspicious and objectionable activities during the examination, will be automatically recorded and will be treated as malpractice, leading to immediate disqualification from the admission process
- The webcam must be installed strictly in front of the system, preferably on the top of the test taking monitor / system, to show your face clearly.
 - The Camera should cover the face and your body up to the upper abdomen.
 - Any other forms of camera installation are not permitted and will be liable for necessary actions.
- Do not use a mask while taking a photo and during the examination, as this photo will be matched during the online examination.
- The candidate face must be fully in view of the camera and no partial or complete exit from the camera's field of view is permitted.
- The candidate's face should be in the centre of the webcam's field throughout the duration of the test.
- The Candidate should ensure that his / her face is evenly lit, and there should not be a light source behind the candidate's face.
- Hair, clothing, face mask, hands, or anything else should not cover the face area at any point in time, throughout the test duration.
- Sunglasses not to be worn during the test. Only transparent and non-reflecting lenses / glasses are allowed.
- The candidate should take the test in solitude with least / no disturbance, and there should not be anyone else in the room apart from the candidate
- It is prohibited to leave the workplace during the examination, and may result in termination of the examination, or other actions as deemed appropriate.
- Do **NOT** use unfair means during examination like Mobile phones, Headphones, iPads, iPods, MP3 players, Android devices, Calculator, Programmable calculators, Books, Bluetooth Earphones, Pager, Health Band, Other app support etc. It will result in immediate disqualification from the admission process.
- You must not interact or communicate with anyone by any means while taking the test.
- The Candidate may use a Pen / Pencil / Eraser and blank sheet(s) for solving questions wherever necessary.
- Keep a transparent water bottle at your table before the start of the examination, if need be, as you are not allowed to move away from the examination screen during the examination
- The University will not be responsible for any time loss due to any malfunction of your devices pertaining to (but not limited to) Hardware, Software, Internet connectivity, Power failure etc.

3.7 MET Score

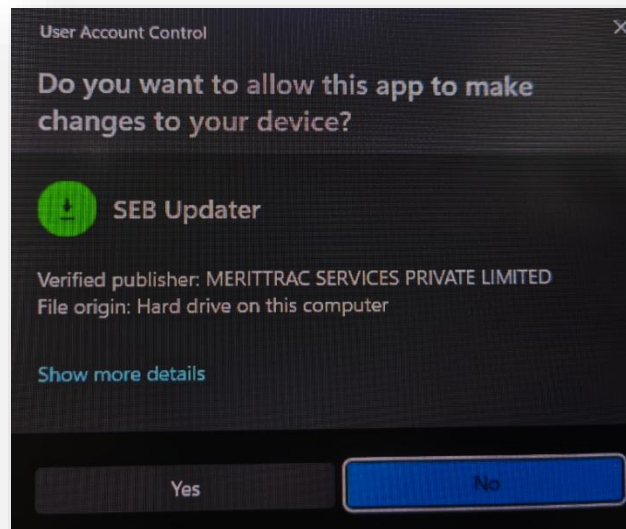
- The score displayed on test submission is provisional.
- On completion of **PhD MET 2026 Batch 1**, there will be a credibility report that will be generated for the University, detailing the various events that have occurred during the entire duration of the test. The audio / video recording of the test and the credibility report will be critically analyzed on completion of the test, for credibility check. Poor credibility score may lead to the cancellation of your examination
 - During scrutiny, in case of evidence of malpractice, the attempt will be nullified, test score will be withdrawn and displayed as MP (Malpractice) and the candidate is disqualified from the admission process
- MAHE Manipal in its sole discretion may disqualify the candidate if the candidate fails to follow the examination instructions or causes a breach in the terms and conditions of online examination, or for any other reason, the University finds appropriate.

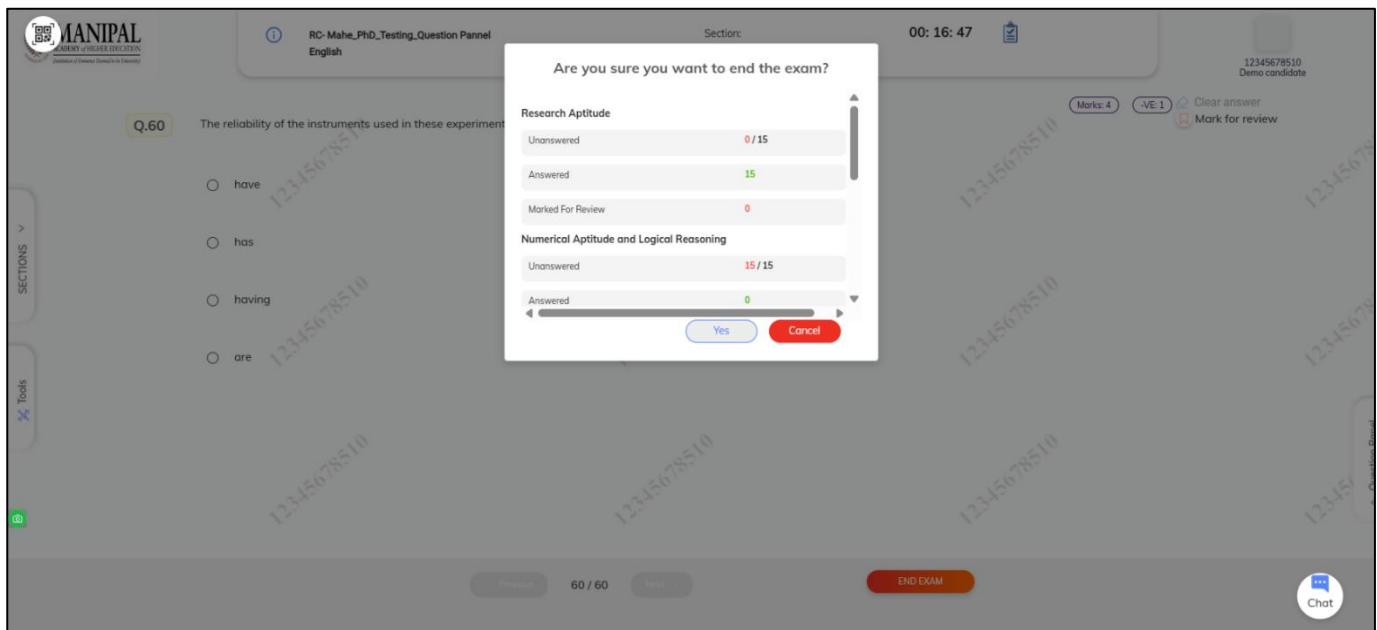


On clicking, a dialog box will appear showing the **summary** of **answered** and **unanswered** questions.

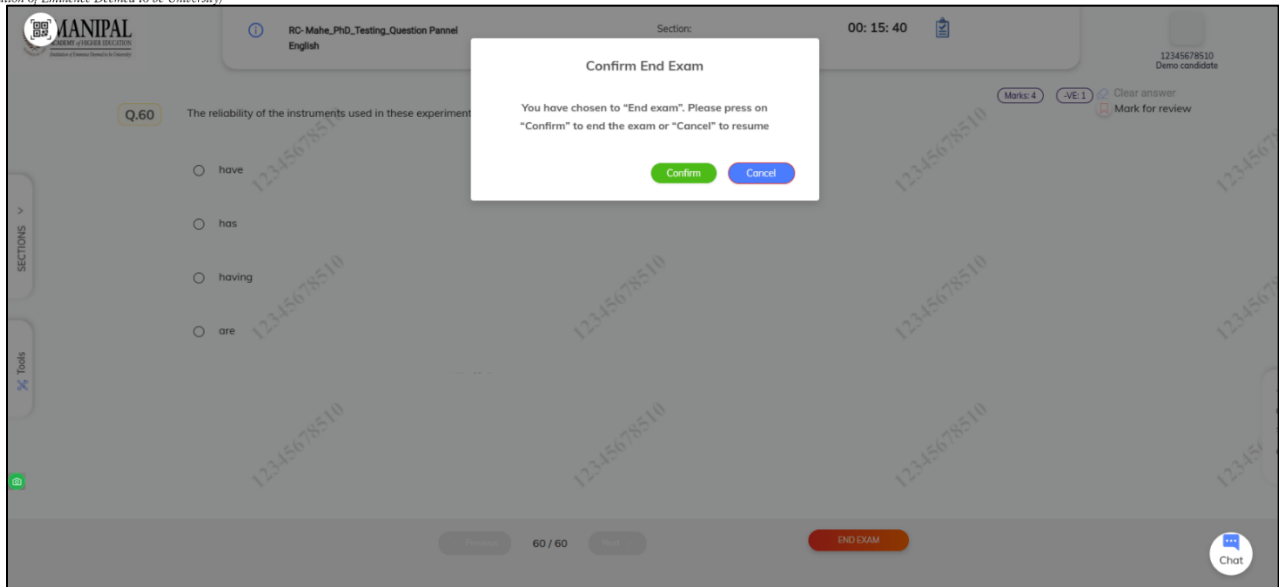

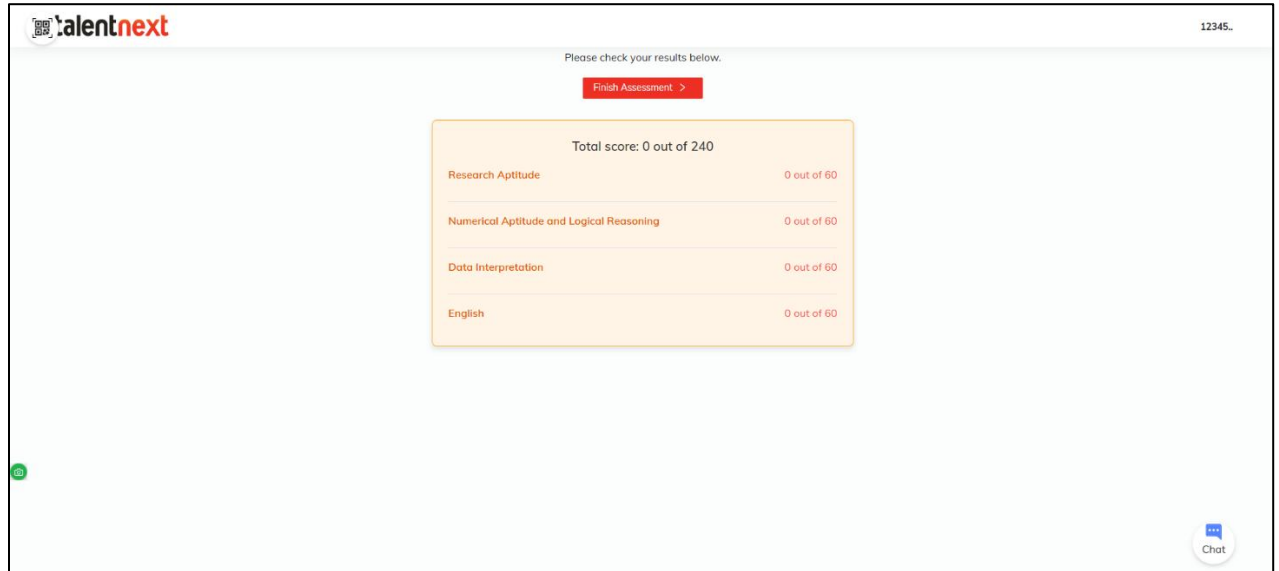
On clicking “**END EXAM**”, a dialog box will appear to confirm your decision. Please click on “**YES**” to end test OR click on “**Cancel**” to resume.
