The field of pharmacy is rapidly evolving beyond traditional boundaries, requiring professionals who are globally connected, research-oriented, and capable of addressing international healthcare challenges. In this context, the International Pharmaceutical Students' Federation (IPSF) plays a vital role in empowering pharmacy students and young professionals through leadership development, education, public health initiatives, and international collaboration.

IPSF is one of the world's oldest international student organizations for pharmacy students and pharmacists, representing over 320,000 students and recent graduates across more than 100 countries. The federation works closely with global healthcare organizations to advance pharmacy education, professional development, and practice worldwide. At Manipal College of Pharmaceutical Sciences (MCOPS), international engagement and student development remain key priorities. MAPS-MCOPS became the first organization in India to receive Membership in Association (MiA) recognition from IPSF during the 62nd IPSF General Assembly held in Harare, Zimbabwe, in August 2016. Since then, MAPS has actively participated in IPSF initiatives, providing students with opportunities for international educational programs, public health campaigns, leadership activities, and global networking.
